



RIICCM202E Identify, Locate and Protect Underarround Services

This hands on training course is specifically designed for individuals that are required to identify, locate and protect buried utilities during excavation work.

Every year site workers are injured and equipment damaged due to accidentally striking buried cables and pipes. In addition, expensive damage to underground utilities can occur if the utilities are not located and suitable protection methods employed to prevent damaging a utility during excavation work.

As the complexity of large underground networks continually increase, having a sound understanding of how to protect these networks has become increasingly important for those in the civil construction and associated industries.
